INVITATION TO BID

The City of Santee invites bids for the Citywide Pavement Repair and Rehabilitation Program 2019. Sealed Bids will be received by the City of Santee at the Office of the City Clerk, 10601 Magnolia Avenue, Building 3, Santee, CA 92071, until 10:00 a.m. on June 12, 2019 at which time they will be publicly opened and read. Work to be done includes the furnishing of all labor, materials and equipment necessary for removal and installation of concrete related work, asphalt patching, asphalt, striping and all related and necessary work as defined in the contract documents.

The City shall award the Contract to the bidder submitting the lowest bid and is deemed responsible by the City as defined in the Notice to Contractors Inviting Bids. Award of the Base Bid will be based upon funds available. The work is to be constructed within forty-five (45) working days from the Notice to Proceed including material lead time. Engineers estimate for the Base Bid is \$368,000. The contractor shall possess a valid Class "A" license at the time of bid submission.

Each Bid is to be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check, cash deposit, or a bidder's bond made payable to the City of Santee, in an amount not less than 10 percent of the total bid submitted. The Successful Bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the Total Bid Price, and a Payment (Material and Labor) Bond in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the Total Bid Price, on the forms provided and in the manner described in the Bid Documents. The Contractor, may, at its option, choose to substitute securities meeting the requirements of said Public Contract Code Section 22300.

Pursuant to Section 1770 et. seq. of the California Labor Code, the successful bidder shall pay not less than the prevailing rate of per diem wages as determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations.

Prevailing Wages are applicable to the Project, which is being managed by the City of Santee. The Project will be subject to the following requirements upheld by the City of Santee:

The Contractor and all subcontractors shall comply with the requirements set forth in Division 2, Part 7, Chapter 1 of the Labor Code. The City of Santee has obtained from the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations the general prevailing rate of per diem wages and the general prevailing rate for holiday and overtime work in the locality in which this work is to be performed for each craft, classification or type of worker needed to execute the Contract. These per diem rates, including holiday and overtime work, as well as employer payments for health and welfare, pension, vacation, and similar purposes, are on file at the City of Santee, and are also available from the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations.
