The proposed wetlands area is approximately 3 acres within a 45-acre parcel and is located south of the western terminus of Mast Boulevard adjacent to the Lakeside Baseball fields on Marathon Parkway in the Light Industrial and Park/Open Space Districts (APN: 379-030-31-00). The project involves minor grading and installation of drainage improvements to convey stormwater runoff from the Hillside Meadows project to the proposed wetlands mitigation area.
