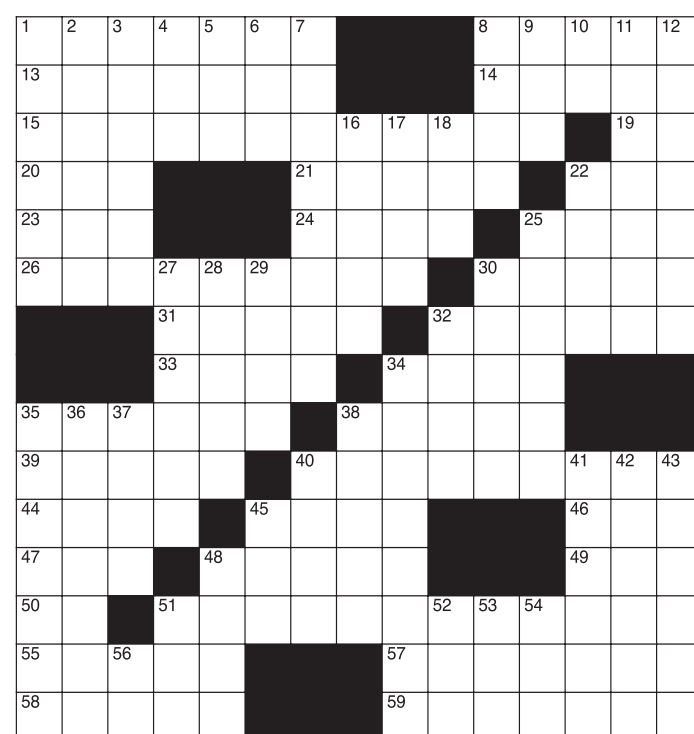

Additionally, the Ordinance allows the District Board of Directors to apply the District's policy for waiver and discharge of certain fees, or to otherwise delegate this authority to the Fire Chief. The Ordinance has no effect on the provision of fire protection, hazardous material emergency response, or rescue services and is not a waiver of any other means of cost recovery available to the District by law.
