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

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



The Housing Element is the City's main housing policy and planning document that identifies housing policy and planning document that identifies housing needs and constraints, sets forth goals, policies and programs that address these needs and constraints in accordance with State housing law, and plans for projected housing needs for all income levels over an eight-year planning period that coincides with a Regional Housing Needs Allocation (RHNA).

The draft Housing Element was transmitted to the California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) on January 28, 2021. The draft Housing Element under consideration for City Council adoption reflects revisions based on feedback from HCD and can be downloaded at the following link:

LOCATION: The Housing Element is a planning and policy document that covers the entire jurisdictional limits of the City of Santee.

CEQA STATUS: Pursuant to the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) an Initial Study (AEIS2019-6) was completed for the project which determined that all environmental impacts of the project would be less than significant.
