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



In ancient Egypt the annual flooding of the Nile occurred as Sirius, the blue-white star left of Orion, became visible just before sunrise. The days (heliacal rising) of Sirius (August 11, specifically August 8th on the west coast of the U.S.) are called the Dog days (Sirius is located in the system Canis Major, Great Dog) of summer (hottest days in northern latitudes).
