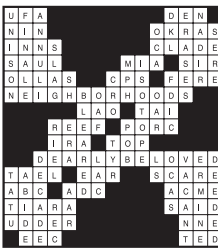

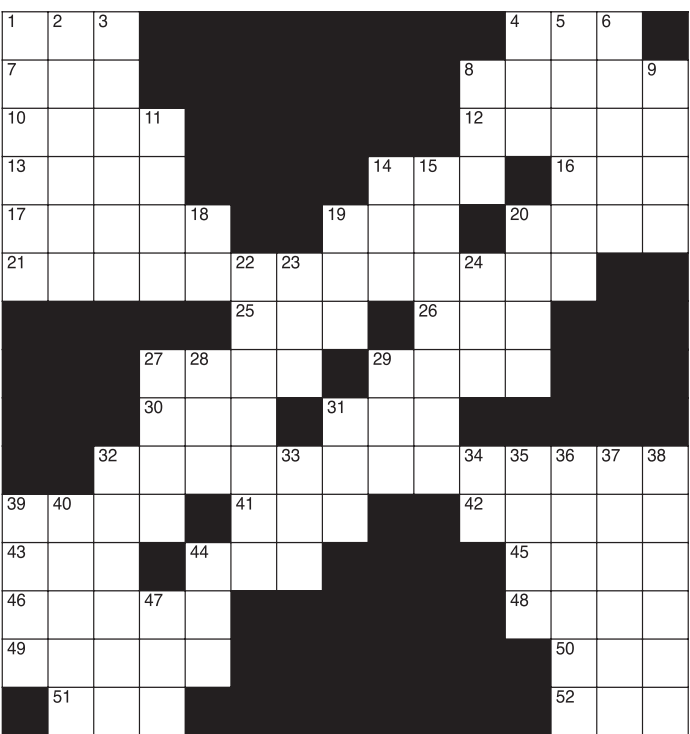

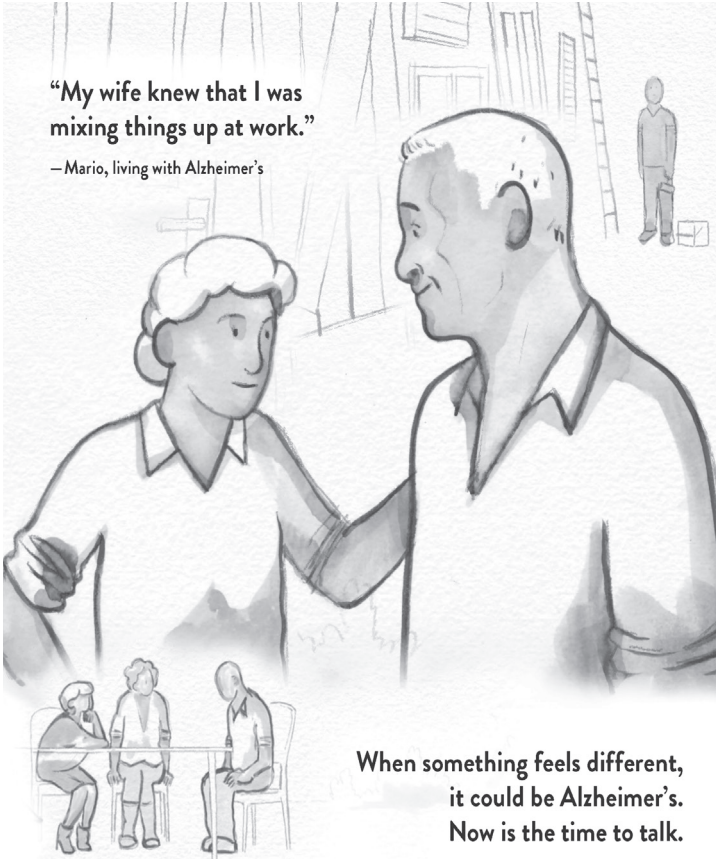

SB 9 ORDINANCES

State Senate Bill (SB) 9 requires cities to: (1) allow any single-family lot to be split, roughly into halves, with resulting lots as small as 1,200 square feet, and; (2) allow up to two single-family dwellings to be developed on each single-family residential lot. The required changes may be approved through a ministerial review process. The bill provides several standards for eligible projects but allows local governments to impose additional objective standards to address local concerns. The proposed ordinances (urgency and non-urgency versions) implement SB 9 by amending Titles 12 and 13 of the Santee Municipal Code to establish objective development standards for specified lot splits and two-unit housing projects. Staff is recommending both an urgency and non-urgency ordinance to ensure that the City's development standards are in place before SB 9 takes effect on January 1, 2022. The proposed ordinances are exempt from environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) per Government Code Sections 65852.21(j) and 66411.7(n).

ADU ORDINANCE

The proposed ADU ordinance would update the City's current ordinance to comply with recent State legislation, as well as making other refinements to reflect best practices and to further streamline the ADU and JADU approval process. The most notable changes to Santee Municipal Code Section 13.10.045 include increasing the maximum square footage to 1,200 square feet and deleting the two-bedroom limit, removing the 800 square foot-maximum for limited detached ADUs on a multi-family lot, and removing the architectural and landscape requirements. The proposed ADU ordinance is exempt from environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) per Government Code Sections 15061(b)(3) and 15378(b)(5) and Public Resources Code Section 21080.17.
