

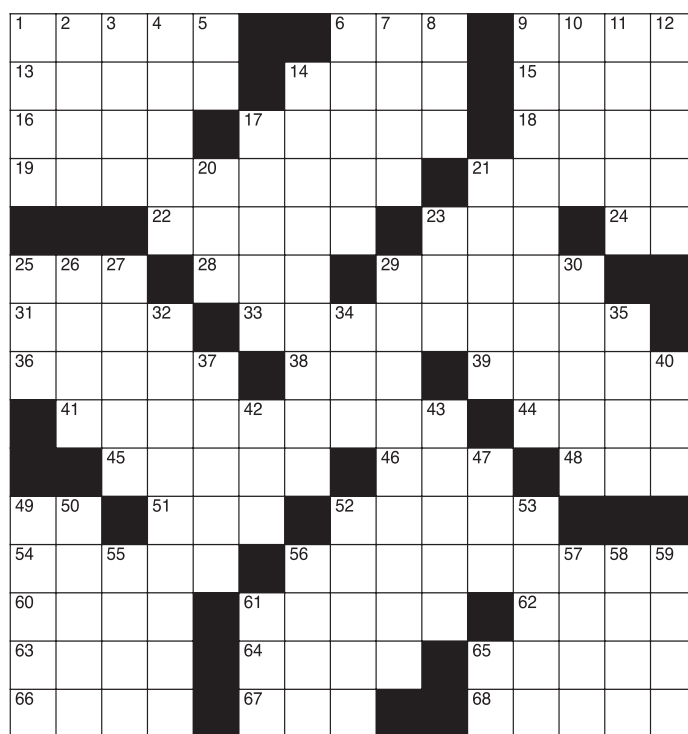

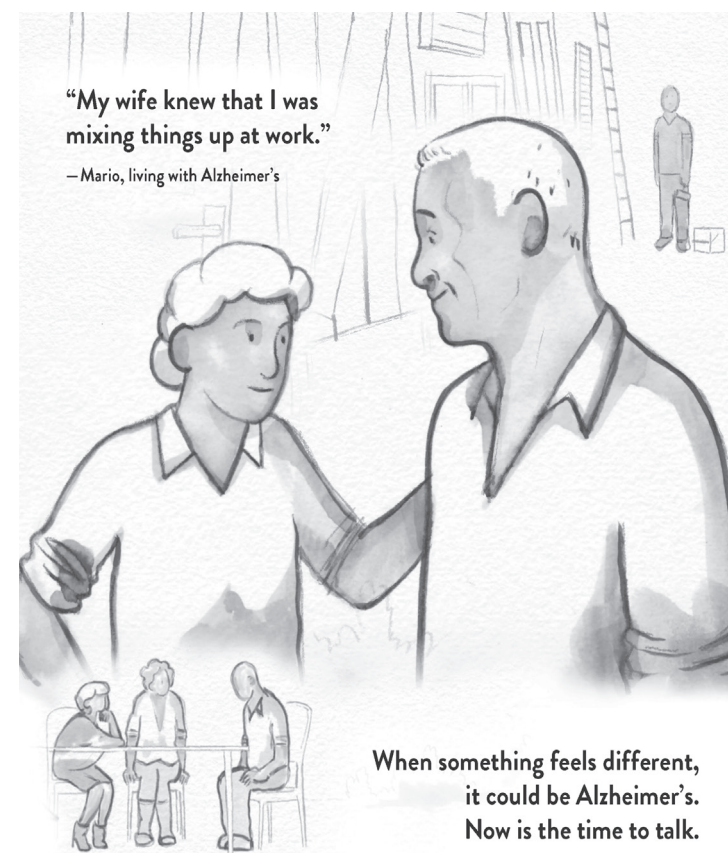
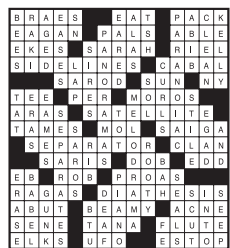

MERCURY IN ARIES – WHAT WE'VE NEVER SAID BEFORE

The new moon for the new spiritual year occurs around midnight this Thursday night, Friday morning (depending on our location). It is the new moon for the new spring season occurring at 11.31 degrees Aries. Notice is hereby given that on March 23, 2022, the City Council of the City of Santee ("City") gave second reading to and adopted Ordinance 601, adjusting the City Council District boundaries, as reflected in the map attached to the Ordinance.

Pursuant to Election Code section 21621, charter cities with by-district election systems are required to redraw their district boundary maps to ensure compliance with the California and federal Voting Rights Acts. The process to complete the redistricting requires a minimum of four public hearings and dedicated public outreach to ensure minority populations and communities of interest are aware of the redistricting effort and are provided with options to participate. The City held its first public hearing on October 13, 2021 and its second public hearing on November 10, 2021. The third public hearing was held on January 26, 2022, with a fourth public hearing held on February 9, 2022. At the February 9, 2022 public hearing, the City Council identified a preferred map, described in the Staff Report as "Map Option 4" ("Preferred Map"). The Ordinance adopts the Preferred Map.

The Preferred Map may be viewed at the following link: <https://davesredistricting.org/maps/viewmap:fc3c0c0d-930d-456a-a384-7e1b6ede6fe4>

The Preferred Map is population balanced with a total deviation of 5.51%. It closely resembles the current boundary map, while moving small populations to lower the total deviation. It creates, compact, contiguous districts. Like the other map options reviewed by Council, the Preferred Map does not create a majority/minority voting district, as the City's minority population does not rise to the level where creation of such a district is possible.

The above summary constitutes the major highlights of the Ordinance. A reading of the entire Ordinance may be necessary to obtain a full understanding of the Ordinance.
