

The stated purpose of the Health Care Workers Minimum Wage initiative is to establish a minimum wage for covered healthcare workers within the boundaries of the City of La Mesa (Minimum Wage). "Covered Healthcare Worker" is defined as an employee who is employed to work at or by a healthcare facility which provides medical patient care, healthcare services or services supporting the provision of healthcare, and includes the following: a clinician, professional, non-professional, nurse, certified nursing assistant, aide, technician, main-tenance worker, janitorial or housekeeping staff person, groundskeep-er, guard, food service worker, laundry worker, pharmacist, administratworker and business office electrical worker

Specifically, Minimum Wage would be set at \$25 per hour for all hours worked as a Covered Healthcare Worker. One year thereafter, and anworked as a Coverleam of the same date, the Minimum Wage would increase based on the annual increase in the cost of living for the preceding twelve months, as measured by the Consumer Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers (CPI-W) for the San Diego area, which is published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics (COLA). If the change to the COLA over the applicable twelve months is negative, the Minimum Wage would not increase or decrease.

The initiative would prohibit an employer from funding the Minimum Wage increases in any of the following ways: 1) reducing Covered Healthcare Workers' premium pay rates or shift differentials; 2) reducing vacation, healthcare, or other non-wage benefits of any Covered Healthcare Worker; 3) Reducing Covered Healthcare Workers' hours of work; 4) laying-off Covered Healthcare Workers; or 5) increasing charges to any Covered Healthcare Worker for parking, work-related materials or equipment.

The initiative would also prohibit any employer from discharging, terminating a contract with, reducing compensation to, or otherwise discriminating against or taking adverse action against any Covered Healthcare Worker for opposing any practice proscribed by the initiative, for participating in proceedings related to the initiative, for seeking to enforce rights under the initiative by any lawful means, or for otherwise asserting rights under the initiative.
