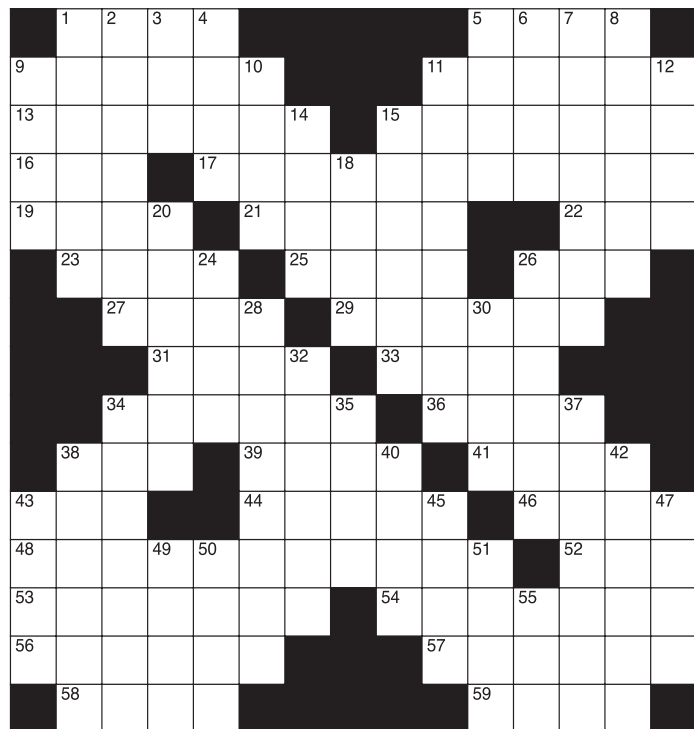

THREE SPRING FESTIVALS - ARIES, TAURUS, GEMINI

- Revise Sections 7.04.410 (A) and (I) to confirm that Cannabis manufacturing within the specifically defined zone districts does not include the use of volatile solvents and that only non-volatile solvents may be used where manufacturing is allowed.
